Students of color are less likely to earn a living wage, 59% of White students earned a living wage, 43% of Black students earned a living wage and 46% of Latinx students earned a living wage.

In San Diego County, **71.4**% of the aggregate income is earned by just **20**% of the population. In Imperial County, the median household income is \$47,622 - a fraction of the median household income in California of \$78,672.
